ORDER

G.M.T. College of Educational, Jalandhar Bypass, Ludiana, Punjab - 141008 submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition of B.Ed. course of one Year duration in terms of section 14(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to G.M.T. College of Educational, Jalandhar Bypass, Ludiana, Punjab for an annual intake of 100 seats (One Hundred) in B.Ed. course of One year duration with effect from 29th January 2005 subject to compliance of the following before the commencement of the session.

- Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/ State Govt./UGC is to be completed before the commencement of the session.
- The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Registrar of the concerned University should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session.
- The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institution shall within one month of the receipt of Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers & Staff be created within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/institution, for a period of not less than sixty months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- Non-compliance of the above mentioned conditions shall cause action under section 17 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

3. The Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating University shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department), as per the norms of the NCTE / UGC / Affiliating University.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and/or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.





Sir/Madam,

It is hereby informed that subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions, the Vice-Chancellor has granted Temporary Affiliation to your above new college with an intake of 100 students to impart instructions in B.Ed. Course w.e.f. the session 2005-2006:

1. ✓ An Endowment Fund amounting to Rs.5 lacs is to be deposited with the University within one month from the date of issue of this letter in the form of F.D.R. in the name of the Registrar, Punjab University, Chandigarh and the Society/Trust.
2. ✓ The college will have to deposit the affiliation continuation fees of Rs.2000/- every year, as per the University norms, latest by 30th September.
3. No other fee and funds than the prescribed Fee by the University/Govt.
4. The Principal, teaching staff and the Librarian will be recruited/appointed as per UGC/NCTE/Punjab University norms/qualifications through a properly constituted Selection Committee under the rules.
5. ✓ The college shall pay salary to the faculty in the UGC grades plus usual allowances as amended from time to time by the State Govt./Punjab University. An affidavit to this effect signed by the President of the Foundation/Trust/Society and duly attested by the Magistrate (First Class) will be submitted to the University within 15 days from the date of issue of this letter. The College will maintain the proper record of the salary of the faculty and staff.
6. The College will send cases of duly selected/appointed Principal/Faculty/Librarian, for approval from the University, within 15 days from the date of their appointment.


7. ✓ The College shall submit the list of faculty members and supporting staff at the beginning of each Academic Year latest by 15th August every year. Any transference of management and other changes in the teaching faculty/staff shall be reported to the University immediately.
8. The College will not, without the prior permission of the Syndicate, cease instruction in any subject or course of study for which it is authorized to impart instructions.
- ✓ 9. The College shall have a regularly constituted Government Body consisting of not more than 15 persons including, among others, the Principal and two representatives of teachers as per University rules/regulations, will hold regular meetings of the Governing Body.
10. ✓ The College building will not be used for any other purpose.
11. ✓ The College once affiliated to this University will not seek affiliation with any other University for any course/subject.
- ✓ 12. The College will submit each year a statement of Annual Accounts to the University duly audited by a Chartered Accountant latest by 1st October every year.
13. The College will impart instructions as per University syllabus.
- ✓ 14. The College must have arrangement with good practicing high/Senior Secondary Schools which should have experienced staff and adequate equipment. The list of such schools, along with a certificate from the school head to this effect, be also supplied to the University within one month from the date of issue of this letter.
15. The College will make available playgrounds to the students duly furnished and appropriate arrangements for extra-curricular activities.
16. The College will ensure compliance of conditions of NCTE, Jaipur imposed vide their letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/F.3/PB-142/12735 dt. 5²/₀₅.
17. The College will be bound to abide by the University/NCTE/Punjab Government rules issued from time to time.
18. **If the College contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the Panjab University Calendar, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the University may withdraw affiliation under Regulation 30 appearing at Page 11 of Panjab University Calendar Volume I, 2005.**

19. As per NCTE/Punjab University rules (4 NET, 6 lecturers) more lecturers be appointed on regular basis immediately through the regularly constituted Selection Committee.
